Code of Conduct

As a member of the 2024 Lunar Rendezvous Festival Court, you are representing 59 years of the festival. This organization is highly regarded within our community. Certain standards are necessary for the integrity and reputation of this organization. Each court member should be a leader within the community and is expected to have and maintain a character above reproach. In addition, court members must always display appropriate behavior.

<u>Unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to the following:</u>

- Smoking/Vaping
- Use of alcohol and/or illegal drugs
- Lack of respect towards Lunar Rendezvous Festival Committee
 Members, Advisory Board Members, and fellow LRF Court Members
- Chronic absences from court activities
- Disciplinary action involving any law-enforcement agency and/or security guards
- Any offense deemed severe by the Lunar Rendezvous Festival Advisory Board
- Suspension from school
- Inappropriate online memberships, postings, or conversations
- Offensive photographs or language posted to Facebook, Twitter,
 Snapchat or other similar social media sites

Failure to act in accordance with the Court Member Code of Conduct will result in dismissal from the Lunar Rendezvous Festival Court at the discretion of the Lunar Rendezvous Festival Advisory Board. All Festival Advisory Board decisions are deemed final. In the event a court member is dismissed for disciplinary reasons, no fees will be refunded.

What to Expect at Each Event

Sunset Service

- This is a casual event.
- Each service project team will present a slide show highlighting their project.
- Royal Court Interest Forms will be distributed.

Fashion Show Rehearsal

- Rehearsal is the afternoon before Fashion Show.
- Big Court members will be presented on the arm of their mother or significant female figure. BOTH MUST ATTEND REHEARSAL.
- Royal Court Interest Forms are due at the rehearsal.
- Bring the shoes you plan to wear.

Fashion Show

- This is a first-class luncheon and professional fashion show. Big Court will be presented before the start of the fashion show.
- A large live and silent auction and raffle will be featured.
- Big Court members will be presented on the arm of their mother or significant female figure, who must wear a dress or dressy pants and top. Shoes will have a back strap. No athletic shoes.

Coronation Ball Rehearsal

- Rehearsal will be Thursday afternoon before the Ball at the Bay Area Community Center.
- Princesses will be presented by their father or significant male figure and escorted by a male peer. ALL THREE MUST ATTEND REHEARSAL.
- Lieutenants will be presented by their mother or significant female figure and escorted by a female peer. ALL THREE MUST ATTEND REHEARSAL.
- Bring the shoes you plan to wear.
- Voting for the new Royal Court will be by ballot.

Coronation Ball

 The ball is a dignified and elegant affair with a fancy dinner, presentation of the Big Court, and dancing.

Dress Code

Events (Socials, Court Meetings, etc.)

Princesses: court polo shirt, khaki pants/capris, or skirt (no shorter than 3" above the knee) and sash

Lieutenants: court polo shirt, and khaki pants

Court Member & Sponsor Photo Session

Princesses: Sunday dress or skirt (no shorter than 3 inches above the knee) and sash for picture with your sponsor. For formal publicity photo, change into a strapless top with shorts or pants and pearls (pearls will be provided, if needed). A black drape will be used for the photo.

Lieutenants: For both photo with sponsor and formal publicity photo, suit or sport coat with dress pants, white shirt, and tie.

Sunset Service:

Princesses: court polo shirt, khaki pants/capris, or skirt (no shorter than 3" above the knee) and sash

Lieutenants: court polo shirt, and khaki pants.

Fashion Show:

Princesses: dress or skirt; and sash. No skirts shorter than 3" above the knee. Dress shoes. No flip flops or backless shoes. No exposed midriff, no shorts, rompers, or jeans.

Lieutenants: suit or sport coat with dress pants, lapel pin, button down shirt, and tie. Dress shoes.

Formal Group Photo and Coronation Ball:

Princesses: WHITE ball gown (NO IVORY), no train. Only clear or opalescence beadwork. White opera length gloves, white or silver dressy shoes or ballet flats. No crowns or tiaras, only small decorative hair pins. **NOTE: Please text a photo of your dress (front and back) and shoes for approval BEFORE purchase.**

Lieutenants: WHITE tuxedo dinner jacket, black tuxedo pants, white tuxedo shirt with winged collar, black vest, black bow tie, and dressy black shoes. PICKUP tuxedo on Wednesday before Ball rehearsal

Presenters and Escorts

Female: formal length gown NO WHITE, SILVER, OR ROYAL BLUE, no tigras.

Male: black tuxedo, white shirt, black bow tie. Dressy black shoes. No boots or hats.

How to Secure a Court Sponsor

Expectation

Each 2024 Lunar Court member is **required** to secure a **Court Sponsor**. Please see below information on where to start and sample script information to assist when asking someone to sponsor you.

Where to start

Start with people you know such as, family members, local businesses, banks, doctors, dentists, veterinarians, insurance agents, real estate agents, employees, etc. The following is a sample script you can use when asking someone to sponsor you. Ask in person or over the phone.

What are the benefits of sponsorship?

Meet as a team to begin discussing which local area non-profit organization your group will sponsor. **EVERYONE** in the group must participate. **Please coordinate your first meeting with your assigned Court Chair. She must be included in your first group meeting.** You can meet at someone's home, Starbucks, restaurant, virtually...your choice. The sooner you get started with the project the better.

As a group, you will plan an original community service project which must be approved ahead of time and be confined to our local area. The plans must be completed by **Sunday May 19, 2024**. Please send your plans to the Big Court Chairs. Organize and execute your project before **Friday**, **June 28, 2024**.

Your group project will be presented at the **Sunset Service** on Sunday, July 14, 2024. Each group will prepare a slide show to highlight their service project.

When contacting an organization to discuss your proposed service project idea, please identify yourself (name) and state that you are a Princess or Lieutenant in the Lunar Rendezvous Festival. Be prepared to answer questions regarding the Lunar Rendezvous Festival and discuss how your idea can benefit their organization.

TAKE PICTURES! We would like to share your service project experience on social media! In addition, you will want to capture and showcase your experience on your project board. Below is a list of suggested local non-profit organizations, but **you are more than welcome to consider other service project opportunities**. Please feel free to reach out to your

assigned Court Chair to discuss your ideas and direction prior to asking for approval. These are just examples. Additional organizations may be researched.

Suggestions:

Organize and execute an adoption drive in conjunction with Second Chance Pets or League City Animal Shelter. Add an appearance on Great Day Houston or other local TV news to promote the event during Adopt-A-Pet segments.

Identify and organize a lawn clean-up service for non-profit organizations such as Bay Area Museum, etc.

Organize and execute a children's clothing drive for the Assistance League of the Bay Area.

Organize and execute a Back-to-School Drive for the Bay Area Turning Point.

Become a Youth United Group with Habitat for Humanity and raise funds towards building a local Habitat House.

Work with the American Red Cross of Great Houston-Clear Lake Area to support local military families and elderly in our area through their Youth Volunteer Mission Related Projects.

Organize and execute a blanket drive for the local Red Cross.

Organize and execute a drive for hygiene kits for under privileged students in the local school systems of CCISD, Dickinson ISD, Friendswood ISD, and Pearland ISD.

Contact Hope Village in Friendswood, a residence for Handicapped Adults, for opportunities.

Organize activities for residents of an Assisted Living facility.

Organize a Book Drive (or toy drive) for Ronald McDonald House, local organizations, and/or libraries.

Plan a fun day for the children in shelter at Bay Area Turning Point.

Work with local libraries to provide activities for children.

Contact Birthday Joy to plan a birthday party for children in need.
